



#### Guitar 101: Introduction to the Guitar and Basic Principles

Dan Duff is a retired coach. He has taught beginning guitar at Trion High and Woodland Middle Schools, and private lessons. His classes cover basic guitar care and various techniques to include chords, scales, intervals to create music the students desire to play.

Lessons run approximately 45 minutes. Handouts and other information will be created on a student need basis. Students are expected to practice daily to be ready for the next lesson. Lessons progress as the student accomplishes proficiency before moving forward.

Class Objectives: As a result of the lessons, the student will be able to:

- Understand the parts and anatomy of the guitar.
- Know how to engage in basic strumming and picking of both open strings and single fretted notes.
- Know how to use a tuner to tune the guitar.
- Know the notes for the first 12 frets on all six strings or at least the high E, low E, and A string.
- Learn how to utilize the Circle of Fifths.
- Be able to play basic power chord shapes (dyads) and the common open chords from the CAGED system.
- Know and be able to use basic minor, major, power, and barre chords.
- Remember and utilize basic major, melodic minor and pentatonic scales.
- Understanding and putting into practice basic soloing technique including bends, vibrato, sliding, and alternate picking.
- Play through and be comfortable with simple chord progressions that allow you to play through full songs.

#### Beginning Quilting - Tools and Techniques

with Dora Dryden

October 25, 10 am to 2 pm, \$25 per person

Overview: If you want to try your hand at the traditional and also modern craft of quilting, this introductory class of basic quilt construction is for you. You will learn techniques for planning, cutting, and construction of a basic quilt block as well as skills in selecting fabrics and materials. Emphasis will be placed on accuracy in cutting and sewing to insure your quilt comes together perfectly. Students will complete a sample block.

You should be able to operate a basic sewing machine and sew a straight stitch. You do not have to know anything about quilt construction.

#### Supply List:

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Thread in a neutral color such as white or cream (50 wt. recommended)
- Seam ripper
- Rotary cutter (45 mm recommended) such as Olfa or Fiskars
- Straight pins and pincushion
- Scissors
- Acrylic ruler (6" x 12" recommended) such as Omnigrid
- 1/4" foot for your machine if you have one but is not required
- At least 1/4 yard of 3 cotton fabrics that you like together a light, medium. and dark or ones that have contrast.


